ENTRIES DUE: **March 23, 2009 (Monday)**
WARM UP TIME: 3:30 PM (Fri), 7:30 AM (Sat/Sun)
MEET START TIME: 4:30 PM (Fri), 9:00 AM (Sat/Sun)

Afternoon Session will begin no sooner than 12:00pm or 45 minutes after the conclusion of the Morning Session

- POOL:** LOWER MARGUERITE AQUATIC COMPLEX, 27474 CASTA DEL SOL, Mission Viejo, CA 92692. Take I-5 to the La Paz exit. Turn east on La Paz, left on Marguerite, right on Casta Del Sol. Turn right at the first driveway. The swim parking lot is behind the tennis courts on the right with the exit being at the upper level. Do not park in the tennis lot.
- COURSE:** The LOWER MARGUERITE AQUATIC COMPLEX POOLS are outdoor, 50 meter pool with up to eight (8) swimming lanes. This competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 (C).
- SPECIAL NOTICE:** Swimmers may swim a maximum of FOUR events per day. **MVN will limit entries to meet the "4 Hour" rule for each session.** Timers must be provided by each team. Out of District swimmers/teams are welcome, however, their entry into the meet will only be allowed once all entered Orange Committee members are accommodated and the "4 hour" rule is met. Swimmers in the 400 Freestyle, 1500 Freestyle and 400 IM must provide timers for three heats. You must provide your own lap counters. **Please note: Swimmers may enter a stroke and distance only once even if it is offered twice. Only swimmers 11 years and older who meet the stated time standard may enter OPEN events. 8 & Under swimmers may enter 8 & Under or 10 & Under events, but not a combination. In order to meet the 4 Hour Rule, the 1500 Meter Freestyle may be swum 2 per lane.**
- WARM UP RULES:** USA Swimming warm-up policies will be enforced by USA Swimming Officials. Swimmers warming up or down before, during, or after this swim meet must be under the direct supervision of an USA Swimming member coach. There will be **NO DIVING** into the pool during these times except into the designated sprint lane(s). **WARM-UP RULES WILL BE ANNOUNCED AND POSTED.**
- MEET REFEREE:** The meet referee shall be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be made directly to that person.
- RULES:** USA Swimming rules will govern. Current SCS Meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this entry form. (See 2009 SCS Swim Guide). Swimmers must check in with the Clerk of Course for each event they wish to swim. After an event has been officially closed, swimmers MAY NOT CHECK IN OR SCRATCH. Swimmers in the first four events must check in **THIRTY MINUTES** prior to the start of the appropriate age group session. Swimmers who check in and fail to swim an event will be disqualified from their next individual event. Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group as determined by their age on April 3, 2009. **In SCS age group events, a swimmer's suit may not extend past shoulder or the knee cap. Swimsuits worn in all Age Group competition (as defined by USA Swimming) shall not extend past the top of the shoulder (the acromial process (a triangular projection of the scapula)), and shall not extend further down each leg than the top of the kneecap (patella). Swimsuits worn in all Age Group competition shall not be constructed of any polyurethane or neoprene material, except post-manufacturing logos and decorations. All events at Committee level meets shall be considered Age Group competition under SCS Rules & Procedures, Part Four, I, E.**
- CHANGE OF AFFILIATION:** Before the meet, a swimmer may change affiliation by submitting a CLUB TRANSFER form and the appropriate fee to the Swim Office. At the meet, a swimmer may UNATTACH by notifying the Administrative Referee in writing and paying the appropriate fee. A swimmer may not attach at the meet.
- ELIGIBILITY:** OPEN TO ATHLETES WHO ARE 2009 USA Swimming REGISTERED. SCS athletes must be members of the Orange Committee to be eligible for entry into this meet. **NO ON-DECK ENTRIES.** Registration applications must be received by the meet host or SCS office prior to the first day of the meet. **REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS MAY BE SUBMITTED TOGETHER WITH ENTRY FORM.** There are substantial penalties to swimmer and Club (See 2009 SCS Swim Guide, Part One, III, B) if USA Swimming registration is completed at the meet.
- SUBMITTED TIMES:** Times submitted must be ***BEST RECORDED LONG COURSE METER TIMES*** from this or preceding swim season (**NO WORK OUT TIMES**). Swimmers must have achieved time standards listed for an event. Coaches and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times. Discrepancy in the submitted times can lead to disciplinary action.
- QUALIFYING TIMES:** Swimmers must have achieved time standards listed for an event. If a swimmer does not have a recorded time but is otherwise qualified, he/she may enter the meet at minimum (see 2009 Swim Guide for exceptions).
- AWARDS:** INDIVIDUAL EVENTS: RIBBONS 1st through 8th
Ribbons will be awarded to the following age groups: 5/6, 7/8, 10 & Under and 11/12. OPEN events will not be awarded.
- ENTRY FEE:** **\$2.75 for each INDIVIDUAL EVENT, plus \$5.00 SURCHARGE per swimmer must accompany each individual entry card.** E-mail entry (entry.zipfile) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached Word or .pdf file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time. (5 PM postmark would queue before a 10PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers may be submitted by hard copy (this includes e-mail) ONLY. New swimmers accepted SPACE AVAILABLE. DO NOT RESEND AN ENTRY FILE. A replacement file for the team will NOT be processed. Deletions will NOT be refunded.
- ENTRIES CLOSE:** Entry forms bearing a postmark LATER THAN 12:00 MIDNIGHT on the due date of entry form WILL BE REJECTED. Space permitting, entries will be accepted if hand delivered to the address below up to 8:00 PM on Tuesday, March 24, 2009. NOTICE: Entries stamped with post office meter machine will be accepted if it arrives three days after the entries are due. (For example, if entry cards are due on a Monday and the envelope, stamped by a business machine arrives at the destination on Friday, it will be rejected). **To avoid any concern regarding receipt of entry card at the designated address, you are advised to enclose a stamped, self-addressed postcard or envelope for return when your entry is received.**

 Swimmers in the 400 IM, 400 and 1500 Meter Freestyles must provide timers for three heats and the 1500 Freestyles must provide lap counters.
 The 1500 Meter Freestyle, 400 Meter Freestyle and 400 IM will be seeded fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys.

In order to meet the 4 Hour Rule, the 1500 Meter Freestyle may be swum 2 per lane.
 Only swimmers 11 years and older, that meet the time standard, may enter OPEN events.
 13/14 and OPEN events will be swum together but awarded separately.
